

## AGRICULTURAL ACCESSORY BUILDINGS

### (Required for Eaton County Agricultural Buildings)

Per the State Construction Code Act (P.A. 230 of 1972), section 10(8) Agricultural Buildings are exempt from compliance with all construction code provisions. However, buildings must meet the definition of agricultural purposes per MCL125.1502a(1)(a) and MCL125.1510(8).
