7. New Business:

Proposed amendment to Benton Charter Township Zoning Ordinance Articles 7,8,9 and Section 14.46 to allow for a Contractor Construction Establishment and Storage of Heavy Equipment.

Tammy Foster stated that no site plan nor wholesale dealership license have been presented to the township.

After some discussion, Tammy Foster was asked to contact our attorney to determine what legal action can be taken to bring the property into compliance.
